Opportunistic FIT kit ordering for primary care

Bowel Screening is now available in the Medtech and Indici Patient Prompt's in the Bay of Plenty region. When accessing the Patient Prompt via the practice management system, GPs can ascertain the bowel screening status of eligible patients and send information to the Bowel Screening National Coordination Centre (NCC) for action.

After a conversation with a patient, GPs can:

- · Medically exclude from the NBSP
- Order a FIT kit for NBSP priority populations (Māori, Pacifica, deprivation 9 & 10)
- · Withdraw from NBSP
